<b>Description</b> If <code>css_styled_content</code> is used for alternative output, there can't be no width calculated because <code>lastImageInfo</code> won't be filled (e.g. by showing videos). Until now a width in the content element needs to be set - otherwise it will be 0 which is wrong and breaks the output - please see attached screenshots.  Solution: If it is 0 (why ever), don't just set it to 0 but to the default width (which is set in the constant editor)  (issue imported from #M11880)
