Hi Georg,

since the newsgroup-server is unavailable till sunday, let's continue here:

Your patch correctly hides empty modules.

But there is one problem with this:

There are some extensions (e.g. llxmltranslate) which create modules with no submodule in it. These are now hidden too, so that you cannot use these extensions any longer.

I think it is illogical that there are modules without submodule, but as long as this is not changed, your patch will have to be adjusted. I think it would be enough to just check for the help module and to remove that, if it is empty.

But you cannot introduce it as long as there are extensions illogically using empty submodules (like llxmttranslate) or you will break them.

But we want to solve this "empty-module"-thing now, right?

Another idea: What, if you add the help module to the list "Access rights" > "Modules" in the user-settings.
