<b>Description</b>			
<p>I have an existing template setup with about 80 lines. After an existing header comment, like "# this is the main template", I entered two blank lines and started typing "page =" (fast, like typing letters or whatever).</p> <p>The results I got in t3editor were "age0p" or "age=p" or "ge=pa", so the characters of "page" and the "0" (shift-0) got mixed and not recognized correctly. Maybe the JS event listeners were too slow.</p> <p>Occurs in Firefox 2.0.0.9, could not reproduce in IE7 and Safari3.</p> <p>(issue imported from #M6827)</p>
