<p>When copying a larger number of pages (63) from a sysfolder, two sets are inserted when they are placed into the page tree (pagename and pagename (copy 1)). This does not happen with smaller batches (say 13 pages in three levels).</p> <p>Seen in 4.5.3 and 4.5.5, reproduced it three times.</p> <p>TYPO3 4.5.5 and templavoila 1.5.5</p> <p>This is a multi-domain installation, with content referenced from one location into the several domains.</p>
