The patch provided with <a href="#">#37481</a> didn't solve the issue unfortunately. Now, if you debug entities with properties of type <code>\Doctrine\Common\Collections\Collection</code> the debugger throws an exception because it tries to cast an array to string. The reason is, that <code>\Doctrine\Common\Util\Debug::export()</code> returns an array or <code>stdClass</code> while we expect a string.
