Description

Subsequent to each calendar single view is a form to order tickets for the respective event. Any number of tickets > 1 will be ignored, only one ticket will be added to cart. (Updating number in cart is nevertheless possible.)
Reason: wrong value for attribute 'name' in field `quantity` (should be "qty").
The following fixes it:
