#### Description

Example structure:

Product => OneToMany => Variant  
BasketItem => ManyToOne => Variant

If Variant is no aggregate root it is deleted when BasketItem is deleted because cascade=all is automatically set in TYPO3\Flow\Persistence\Doctrine\Mapping\Driver\FlowAnnotationDriver per default.  
Around line 540.

This (IMHO not very helpful) default behavior cannot be overwritten by the annotation because cascade={} throws errors.
