Description <p>Currently, the default value for the FormViewHelper attribute <i>"method"</i> is NULL, resulting in the output form attribute value <i>"post"</i>. This could possibly lead to strange behaviour in the code when checking for the method attribute value (NULL will actually evaluate to TRUE for both checking if <i>method</i> !== 'get' and <i>method</i> !== 'post') and also contradicts the HTML specification for forms, which sets the default method to "get":</p> <p>see http://www.w3.org/TR/html401/interact/forms.html#h-17.3 and http://www.whatwg.org/specs/web-apps/current-work/multipage/association-of-controls-and-forms.html#attr-fs-method</p> <p>This is a concern especially since the CSRF change, which only appends the token on non-GET method and validating the output in the Viewhelfertest package.</p> <p>I hence suggest setting the default value for the method attribute to 'get' - or if a breaking change is to be avoided at least set it do 'post'.</p>
