Description A simple translation which is not meant for handling plurals is not correctly resolved when used with arguments, for example, <pre><f:translate id="someId" arguments="{0: 2500}" /></pre> does not resolve correctly. The error appears in \TYPO3\Flow\l18n\Translator::translateById where the \$pluralForm equals to 'other' as soon as arguments are set (that's the distant observation so far, have to dig deeper).

the actual reason is, that \TYPO3\Flow\l18n\Translator::getPluralForm per convention takes arguments' first item, if it's the only one and numeric, as quantity. So the above mentioned example is such a case where this problem occurs.
