Just a usability suggestion which would correct a minor usability annoyance.			
Situation:			
Page view: Multiple elements exist on one page. You have to scroll a bit to reach the last element. After deleting/hiding an element from the bottom the page frame "scrolls" to the top because it's reloaded. If you want to take some other action in the same spot you have to find it and scroll there again.			
Suggestion:			
After deleting/hiding a content element the scroll position should be retained or restored.
