#### Description

The TYPO3 core has several extensions that once were maintained with the core but now are extracted to live standalone on GitHub and TER. Examples for that for instance are

- compatibility6 (<https://github.com/FriendsOfTYPO3/compatibility6/blob/master/Resources/Private/Language/>)
- compatibility7 (once TYPO3 CMS v8 is released)
- mediace (<https://github.com/FriendsOfTYPO3/mediace/tree/master/Resources/Private/Language/>)

Fetching language files for e.g. German has outdated labels for compatibility6.

Fetching <https://typo3.org/fileadmin/ter/c/o/compatibility6-l10n/compatibility6-l10n-de.v7.zip> instead of <https://typo3.org/fileadmin/ter/c/o/compatibility6-l10n/compatibility6-l10n-de.zip> however worked as local work-around.

I'm not sure whether this is an issue of the translation server or of the core. Tweaking the core in `typo3/sysex/Classes/Service/TerService.php` with the following did the trick to fetch the proper localization files:
