<p>the backend function <code>authCodesMailAction()</code> in <code>backendController.php</code> tries to read ALL users, ALL Usergroups and ALL TT Addresses of the TYPO3 installation.</p> <p>if you have many domain Instances in one TYPO3 installation with 14 languages , the tt Addresses list may result in a endless unreadable form (we have more than 300 Addresses over 8 languages)</p> <p>But the bigger problem is the usage of FE users list:</p> <p>having an instance with > 150000 users will, i think, crash on nearly all servers with a "out of memory" message when the <code>\$userRepository->findAll()</code> is started and converted as value Array "users" to the FLUID template ...</p> <p>Usage of these two features should be configurable in settings of the extension</p> <p>If wanted , i can create a patch for this (actually i just commented the lines that generate the unwanted arrays)</p>
