<b>Description</b>			
Since <a href="#">#82991</a> "Localization view" is always used in list module.			
When working with localizations in a system, the option "Localization view" in the list module is a pre-requisite for all editors, for all installations without languages, the checkbox is not necessary.			
To streamline this behaviour, the option is removed and the functionality is enabled BY DEFAULT.			
If there's only one language defined, the fields "[Localization]" and "Localize to" waste precious space and should be removed.

I changed this to TYPO3 10 and candidate for major version hoping to give it more attention.

Removing the option "Localization view" did lowered a lot the usability of the backend when there are many records and many languages. In my use case they aren't even so many (just ~50 records with 4 languages) and it's already nearly impossible to manage the list.

As a side note: when I use TYPO3 as an editor I find many annoyances which I'm sure the developers don't realize because they don't use the backend enough as editors with complex websites (many images, many pages, many records and languages and so on) and I think that this issue should be handled seriously in some way because the experience of the editors is very important for the success of a CMS.

I don't know if the issues are prioritized in any and what might contribute to an issue or topic getting bumped up in priority or importance.

Also what might be helpful if there were an initiative or a component merger for backend / editor UI or backend / editor UX - which there is currently not - not any component merger for backend UI / UX or editor experience at all, see [Component Mergers](#) or [Initiatives](#)

Maybe someone has a better idea of how to move forward with this general topic or get it on someone's radar.

P.S. If you find something lacking, see if there is anything you can do to help. There are some positive examples of initiatives where the topic was important to an individual or a group and they just started and worked on it and it evolved into an initiative.

same thing here. I work at a university with a large university website. I don't work as editor normally, but I sometimes have to reproduce problems or find solutions when editors report problems.

I have thought about conducting survey or doing something like usability tests with our editors for the TYPO3 backend (and of course also our custom adjustments).
