Case "Auto redirect": (>= v10.1) An editor changes the slug of a page several times back and forth. A redirect is always created, no matter if it already exists. Possible solution: Optimal would be a hash value which is created from all 8 values.

- Page with name 'page' and slug '/page'
- Change slug to '/page-with-new-slug'
- A redirect is created now
- If you now recalculate the slug, it will say '/page' again
- Accessing '/page' will give you a redirect loop in frontend
