When using the "typo3/cms-seo": "10.4.5" I get an error when selecting 1.0 as sitemap_priority.			
Steps to reproduce			
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Edit a page2. Go to SEO tab3. Set sitemap_priority to 1.04. Press save5. Follow error is shown in the flash message: 2: SQL error: 'Out of range value for column 'sitemap_priority' at row 1' (pages:1)			
All the other values are working but the 1.0 isn't.			
I'm not sure how the fix should look like, but should not be something to complex to fix.
