Description

Steps to reproduce

1. Go to the permissions Module (also known as "access module")
2. Select a level which allows to display min. 2 pages
3. Click on min. 2 pages on the owner name to open the select element
4. Select a new owner on the first page and do not save
5. Select another owner on another page and save

Actual

The owner selected in step 4 is stored.

Expected

The owner selected in step 5 is stored.
